Absentee Bids

ABSENTEE BIDS

To place an absentee bid, please fill out the enclosed form on the next page and return it to: The Stanley Museum, P.O. Box 77, Kingfield, Maine 04947 U.S.A. It is requested that you enclose a check or money order equal to 20% of the total amount of your bid(s). The deposit will be credited toward any successful purchase or refunded promptly if your bid(s) are not successful.

Your bids will be executed competitively. The bidding is not opened with your bid. If bidding ceases below the amount you have bid, you will be the buyer at the next raise above the last bid from the audience. Therefore, it is often the case that items may be purchased well below your stated limit. Your limit should be the maximum you would be willing to bid assuming you were bidding in the audience.

SUCCESSFUL BIDS

If your bids are successful, you will be promptly notified by phone within 24 hours after the sale. Upon receipt of any balance of funds due, purchased items may be released for pick-up, shipping or disposition of your choice.

PHONE BIDS

Telephone bids will be accepted at the discretion of the Museum and the auctioneer. Arrangements must be made well in advance of the sale and confirmed by letter, telegram, facsimile or E-mail. Absentee bids will be executed by a representative of the Museum.

The Museum executes absentee bids as a convenience to those who are unable to attend the sale and will not be held responsible for errors, omissions or failure to successfully execute order or phone bids. Please return the Absentee Bidder's form at your earliest convenience. In the event of identical bids, the earliest bid received will take precedence.

ONLINE BIDDING

Bidders will also be able to participate in remote bidding in real time via the internet. Online bidding will be available through Proxibid at www.proxibid.com. Bidders electing this option will be able to see and hear the auctioneer and submit bids just as though they were present in the auction hall.

Online bidders will have to register for this service through Proxibid's website in addition to registering as bidders with the Stanley Museum as described in the Terms and Conditions of Sale on the inside front cover of this catalogue. Successful bidders using the online Proxibid service will also incur an additional surcharge of 3% to the existing

Buyer's Premium. Combined with the Stanley Museum's 10% Buyer's Premium, this will result in a buyer being subjected to 13% on a purchase via online bidding.

Any questions about registering to bid and other auction inquiries should be directed to the Stanley Museum, and we will try to answer your questions promptly.

BUYER'S PREMIUM

Your designated bid is for the "hammer" or sale price; a premium of 10% will be added to the hammer price of each lot to be paid by the successful bidder. Please review the ***Terms and Conditions of Sale*** on the inside front cover page of this catalogue.

SHIPPING

Packing and shipping of purchases are arranged solely at your discretion. In no event shall the Museum or Auctioneer be held responsible for any loss, damage, or liability relating to packaging, shipping, transportation or storage of items purchased.
